The Department of Botany came into existence in 1980 together with the Dawei College, then that is the Dawei University in 2000.

The Department of Botany, Dawei University has a small but dynamic team consisted of two Professors including one Head of Department, four Associate Professors, eight Lectures and three Assistant Lectures in 2019- 2020 Academic Year.

Bachelor of Science (BSc)

Higher education brought the fulltime legal education course in the name of BSc degree in 1980. It become a four years, full-time course of study at the Department of Botany. The Bachelor of Botany degree program remained the main vehicle for University legal studies at all Botany, Department of Universities.

Master of Science (MSc)

The first post graduate legal degree program at the Department of Botany, The MSc degree program, was established in 2000. The MSc program presently run is two years in duration. BSc graduates from Dawei University, who are qualified to attend MSc, are directly admitted into the MSc program at the Dawei University, Department of Botany. During their first three semesters students take requisite Masters level course and are assessed by examination. During their final semester, students must undertake their own research and produce a written thesis.

Master of Research (MRes)

This is a one year program delicates to researching the Botany. Students were required to develop and produce a significant piece of scholarship during their candidacy. MSc degree holders who are qualified to do research are admitted to this program. This will be no more MRes programme at Dawei University starting from 2019-2020 Academic year.
